# Lead a brief discussion with students using the following questions:

#### 1. At the beginning of the story, Jon uses virtual reality for training.

- Do you think this technique is effective for his dangerous missions?
- How does Jon manage to get out of the virtual mission?
- Do you think it was the right way?

## 2. The title of volume 7, *The Ultimate Symbol*, refers to a surprising discovery that disrupts the Agency's regular activities. What is that discovery?

- Is this good or bad news for the Agency? Why?
- How would you have reacted to the news if you were in Jon's shoes?
- Why is this discovery related to the Agency's origins?

#### 3. Why do you think Big Beaver is back?

- What do you like and dislike about him?
- What is his ultimate goal?
- 4. To find Big Beaver, Jon gathers Agency members for a dangerous rescue mission. What is his plan?
  - How does he show ingenuity to succeed in this mission?
  - Have you ever been in a situation in which you needed to show ingenuity? Explain.

Ask students to think individually about the ending of *The Ultimate Symbol*, then ask them to get into small groups to discuss their creative answers.

- 2. Will the Agency be saved?

#### CLASSROOM ACTIVITIES LED BY THE TEACHER


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At the beginning of the story, we meet a new character from the Agency. Who is it?
